Please read the following to understand our policies. All families attending must agree to and abide by the principles, policies, and procedures of this program, listed below, and will be asked to confirm their consent when they complete the on-line [Google Registration Form](#).

Parents, please review all of this with your students as they will be held responsible for this as well.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

Families enrolled in the Coastal Extension Class Program are asked to affirm the following Statement of Faith, which summarizes the most fundamental beliefs of the church:

- The Bible to be the inspired and infallible Word of God and constitutes completed and final revelation. The Bible, in its original autograph, is without error in whole and in part including theological concepts as well as geographical and historical details.
- God has existed from all eternity in three persons: God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. Jesus Christ was God in human flesh being fully God and Fully man except without sin.
- All men are in violation of God's righteous requirements and His holy character both by nature and act; and are therefore under His wrath and just condemnation. The central purpose for the coming of Jesus Christ was to pay the penalty for man's sin through His substitutionary death on the cross—the successful accomplishment of which was attested to by His subsequent visible, bodily resurrection.
- Salvation is offered as a gift; free to the sinner. This gift must be responded to in individual faith, and not trusting in any personal works whatsoever, but the sacrificial death of Jesus Christ.

CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

GENERAL EXPECTATIONS OF PARENTS

- Respect any instructions given by Coastal Extension Class Program staff and personnel.
- Pay Registration Fees and Tuition according to published deadlines. -
- Bring your children to campus with sufficient time for them to get to class on time.
- Pick up your children promptly (within 5 minutes) after the class period ends.
- Participate in the Parent Helper Program to insure the safety of our students.

GENERAL EXPECTATIONS OF STUDENTS

While on the school campus each student is expected to behave in a responsible manner by:

- Participating in class and helping to maintain an atmosphere that encourages learning.
- Demonstrating courtesy and respect for others.
- Attending classes regularly and on time.
- Completing assignments and bringing appropriate materials to class.

- Being well groomed and dressing appropriately for a learning environment.
- Obeying all campus and classroom rules.
- Respecting the rights and privileges of other students, teachers, and parents whether on or off campus.
- Respecting the property of others, including school property and facilities.
- Cooperating with or assisting the Coastal Extension Class Program staff in maintaining safety, order, and discipline.

GENERAL MISCONDUCT VIOLATIONS

Students are prohibited from:

1. Leaving school grounds without permission of Coastal Extension Class Program personnel.
2. Possessing or using matches or a lighter except as part of an instructional program.
3. Possessing or using a firearm, ammunition, weapon or dangerous material.
4. Possessing, using, giving, receiving, selling, or buying any illegal drug, drug paraphernalia, or simulated illegal drug.
5. Possessing, using, or being under the influence of any alcoholic beverage.
6. Possessing, smoking, or using tobacco products including e-cigarettes, vape pens, or any simulated smoking product (whether using a nicotine laced product or not.)
7. Failing to comply with lawful directives given by Coastal Extension Class Program personnel.
8. Behaving in any way that disrupts the class environment or educational process.
9. Violating safety rules.
10. Using skateboards and scooters on campus.
11. Violating dress and grooming standards.
12. Violating other communicated campus or classroom standards of behavior.
13. Being in facilities designated for the opposite sex or other restricted areas.
14. Using cellphones during classes in any manner other than directed by the tutor.
15. Public display of romantic affection between students.

We agree to follow the code of conduct listed above. We understand that my child will face disciplinary action for misconduct violations which may include suspension, dismissal or expulsion and that criminal actions will be reported to the police or legal authorities.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY

As a Christian group, Coastal Academy seeks to follow the biblical mandate that disallows bringing charges against Christian brothers in civil courts. We also seek to be good stewards of the resources and blessings the Lord has provided. Our group has never had an instance of injury or damages being charged to the group. Yet we believe it is best to be sure that all members understand our position prior to any mishaps.

We are a loosely organized, not for profit, group of Christian families. Neither our group nor its leaders, nor its members are liable for any injuries or damages, whether connected with a Coastal Academy event or not.

It is expected that any enrolled parent, or their child who damages property or who causes injury, either willfully or through neglect, will take personal responsibility for their actions. Our group will not be involved in any way in such situations. Any person, who has such a claim will be directed to discuss the offense individually with the party they believe to be responsible. The outcome of such a problem is out of the realm of this group's responsibility. If the parties cannot handle such disputes individually, we will expect that they follow the guidelines of Matthew 18 through their own churches and church leadership.

Parental Agreement - I have read the above and agree to hold Coastal Academy and/or its leaders harmless in the event of any damages or injuries to me, to my children, or to my property.

MEDICAL RELEASE OF LIABILITY

I (We) the undersigned parent, parents, or guardians of the minor child(ren) enrolled in the Coastal Extension Class Program, do hereby authorize and consent to any X-ray examination, anesthetic, medical or surgical diagnosis and treatment and emergency hospital care which is deemed advisable by and is to be rendered under the general or specific supervision of any member of the medical staff and emergency room staff licensed under the provisions of the Medical Practice Act and on the staff of any acute general hospital holding a current license to operate a hospital from the State of California Department of Health Services. It is understood that this authorization is given in advance of any specific diagnosis, treatment or hospital care being required but is given to provide authority to render care, which the aforementioned physician in the exercise of his/her best judgement may deem advisable. It is understood that every effort shall be made to contact the undersigned prior to rendering treatment to the patient, but that any of the above treatment will not be withheld if the undersigned cannot be reached. This authorization is given pursuant to the provisions of Section 25.8 of the Civil Code of California. The undersigned also assumes the responsibility for any of the costs connected with such treatment and hereby releases the leaders and members of Coastal Extension Class Program or Coastal Academy from any liability therefore.

We understand that the Coastal Extension Class Program administration will utilize the doctor/insurance submitted on the Registration Form to provide appropriate treatment (only after trying to reach the parent/emergency contact.)

REGISTRATION FEES/TUITION PAYMENTS

Registration Fees – Registration is not complete until Registration Fees have been paid to Coastal Academy. After submitting the online Registration Form, an invoice will be emailed to each enrolling family at the following rates and when payment is made, registration will be complete.

Registration Fee Rates (annual – non-refundable)

- \$70 for the 1st class
- \$60 for each additional class

Tuition – Tuition fees will be paid directly to the tutor via their preferred method (check, cash, Venmo, Zelle etc.). Payment is due by the first day of class.

Tuition Rates

- \$350/course per year if paid on the 1st day of class.
- \$200/course per semester if you choose to pay in two payments (1st semester and 2nd semester)
